QUESTIONS ON CURRICULUM

1. Does the school have concentrations in my area of interest?
2. What are the academic or career concentrations that you offer?
3. Which electives are among the most popular, regardless of concentration?
4. Does the program let me take electives in my preferred area prior to my summer internship?

QUESTIONS ON QUALITY CAREER ADVICE

1. What is the level of student satisfaction with the career office?
2. How is the career advising staff organized?
3. How does the career advising staff interact with students?
4. What is the role of student career clubs in the career search?
5. In what ways do second-year MBAs participate in the career advising of first-year MBAs?
6. When do I receive access to the alumni database?

QUESTIONS ON ACCESS TO EMPLOYERS

1. What are the top hiring firms over the past five years by volume for internships and full-time hiring?
2. What are the top geographic areas for full-time employment? What percentage of graduates landed there?
3. How many unique employers conducted on-campus interviews in the last academic year?
4. What are the formal ways for me to engage with employers?
5. Which functions, industries, or geographic areas is the school investing in to develop its employment base further?
